Morning Yard Procedure!

We are going to change how the children enter school starting Monday. The doors will open from which the children normally 8.45am to allow children to come into school and go straight into class (they will not line up). If you need to speak to a class teacher in the morning you will need to come to the front office before 8.45 am as from time teachers will need to be in class ready to receive the children. After this time can be the office staff or Leadership will be happy to speak to parents and pass on any messages. It is hoped that this will reduce congestion and allow for lessons to begin promptly at 9.00 as the register closes.

Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is free to all children from Nursery to Y6. Breakfast is served from **8.00am** and no later than **8.25am**. There is a choice of cereals followed by toast and washed down with fruit juice, milkshake or cordial. Watch out for our themed weeks at the end of each term!
