Home Packed Lunch

Please do not send any nuts or nut products in your child's lunch, we have children in school who have nut allergies and need to ensure their safety. Also, if you are putting grapes in these need to be cut length ways and not left whole. Finally, please ensure the lunch box consists of a well-balanced diet and does not include sweets or chocolate.

Free School Meal Entitlement

If you think you may be eligible to receive free school meals, please ring 01772 531809. Please note that this also includes children who will be in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who are entitled to receive Universal Free School Meals, it means school will receive extra money to help your child.

Secondary Admission for September 2017

If your child is in Year 6 you will need to apply for their High School place. The deadline for applications is 31st October 2016. www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools. Speak to Mrs Walters or Mrs Constable if you are having difficulties.

Primary Admission for September 2017

If your child has a 4th Birthday between 1st September 2016 & 31 August 2017 they will start primary school in September 2017. You will still need to apply for a place even if your child attends a nursery linked to a primary school. The deadline for applications is 15th January 2017. www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools. Speak to Mrs Walters or Mrs Constable if you are having difficulties.
