If you think you may be eligible to receive free school meals, please ring 01772 531809. Please note that this also includes children who will be in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 who are entitled to receive Universal Free School Meals, it means school will receive extra money to help your child.

#### Secondary Admission for September 2017

If your child is in Year 6 you will need to apply for their High School place. The deadline for applications is 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016. <u>www.lancashire.gov.uk/schools</u>. Speak to Mrs Walters or Mrs Constable if you are having difficulties.
