School Cash Office Payment

From **30 April 2018** any users of Microsoft Windows XP or Microsoft Vista will no longer be able to make payments via the Tucasi Online Payments System which are processed by WorldPay. Users of these operating system may have to upgrade their systems to be able to make online payments from the 30th of April 2018. This change is being enforced by the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard. From the 30th June 2018, websites that accept card payments will no longer allow users of Windows XP/Vista to use their websites. WorldPay are implementing this change on 30th April 2018. While you will be able to access Tucasi SCO, view the content and perform tasks in the normal way, you will receive an error message and payments will fail to process if you attempt to pay online.
