Are You Entitled?

Answer the questions on the website, it will navigate you to the GOV.UK—Access childcare support through the childcare service webpage https://childcare-support.tax.service.gov.uk/. When you are able check your eligibility you will need your National Insurance Number and other personal information. If you are entitled to the additional 15 Hours Extended free provision you will be given a 11 digit code. This is then brought to our school office along with parents date of birth, NI number and full name of child. The code is checked with Lancashire authority to authenticate. This will need to be checked before we finish for the summer break on 21st July 2017.
