App Download

Open your app store on your phone/device and search '*School jotter*', click install. Type '*PR72LR*' and click on 'Chorley All Saints' Church of England Primary School'. This will sign you up to the School app. You will receive notifications when news/newsletters are shared, however you may need to check your phone settings to allow notifications to come through.

School Drivers - My Health, My Aspirations, My Values

Our new school Curriculum is up and running and is underpinned by 3 key drivers:

My health – ensuring the children leave All Saints' knowing how to keep themselves, their minds and their bodies healthy.

My Aspirations – ensuring the children leave All Saints' full of aspiration from learning about the success of others in today's world, from the past, in our Community, our nation and nations all over the world.

My Values – ensuring the children leave All Saints' with strong Christian values underpinned by the teaching of our Lord and the Bible.

Attendance

Government guidance states that attendance is now compulsory for all children from September. As pre lock down, you are required to let us know if your child is ill/ not attending. Please contact the school using the normal procedures. Mrs Trainor is attendance lead in school and will be calling if your child is absent and will update you on any attendance related issues.

If your child becomes unwell (see additional letter 'Changes to National Self Isolation Guidance')

If your child presents with any of the symptoms below they must isolate for 10 days and arrange to have a test.

- high temperature this means you feel hot to touch on your chest or back (you do not need to measure your temperature)
- new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours (if you usually have a cough, it may be worse than usual)
- loss or change to your sense of smell or taste this means you've noticed you cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal

If your child becomes unwell in school, we will call you to collect them as we normally do. In order to reduce the risk of spreading any illness, your child will wait with a member of staff in the staff room and you must collect them from the school office. The member of staff waiting with the child will wear PPE including a mask, gloves and apron and follow washing procedures.

Children in school can have a COVID19 test. If your child tests negative, they may return to school. If your child tests positive, you must let school know as soon as possible.
